

## Law and Policy Advising Form

**Law and Policy (LP)** majors develop and learn to apply complex problem solving skills in areas where law and policy intersect. Majors study the structure (**POLSC 248**: The Judiciary) and philosophical underpinnings of the legal system (**LP/PHILO 255**: Philosophy of Law) while also taking two law electives, one policy elective, and a law-related internship which must be approved by the student's LP advisor. Use the color-coded advising sheet below to follow the advised course of study in the major.

**Note:** This is only a suggested "course flow" strategy. Your pace and timing may be somewhat different, depending both on when the decision to declare the major is made, and what other academic goals (e.g., study abroad; Washington semester) are in play.
